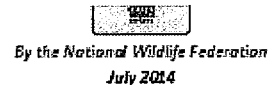

**Subject:** Emergency Waterline Repair @ W Oakland Park Blvd and NW 18th Ave

David,

Public Works is requesting the City Manager and Mayor declare work associated with replacing a broken 8" water main on Oakland Park Blvd at NW 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue an emergency under the City Code.

#### **Background**

The Water Distribution Division is in need of making repair of an 8" asbestos-cement (AC) water main in the southwest quadrant of Oakland Park Blvd & NW 18 Ave. The line is broken just inside a 10" or 12" sleeve under NW 18 Ave. The matter is complicated by:

- The FDOT's West Oakland Park Blvd Improvement Project. FDOT is preparing to close the project out and cannot until this line is repaired; and
- A crosswalk signal pole is situated directly on top of the sleeve/water main that will need to be removed and reset after the waterline repair.

This water main is required in order to complete the water main loop in this area to insure adequate fire flow. It is anticipated to replace the AC pipe with PVC C-900 or Ductile Iron as well as to install additional isolation valves to enhance our operational capabilities of the water mains in this area. Water Distribution is working with FDOT on securing a utility permit for this repair as well as for a contractor to remove the crosswalk pole and associated electrical junction boxes.

A "not to exceed" quotation for the water main repair has been provided by Molloy Brothers Inc. (see attachment) based on their Annual Utilities Restoration Contract # 25311666-3 with the City of Fort Lauderdale, expiration March 13, 2018. Molloy's "not to exceed" price is \$37,903.

#### **Emergency Procurement**

Since this work is needed to be start immediately after securing permits from FDOT, and the repair is estimated to exceed \$25,000, Public Works is requesting the City Manager and Mayor declare the work required an emergency under the City Code.

Per the City Code, emergency contractual services above \$25,000 need joint authorization from the City Manager and Mayor, and then forwarded to City Commission at the next scheduled Commission meeting. In this case, the next meeting after the work is complete would be November 30, 2016.

From our Code:

Emergency procurements. The city manager may make emergency procurements of supplies or contractual services where the cost exceeds twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) when there exists a clear and present threat to public health, property, welfare, safety or other substantial loss to the city, when joined in said action by the mayor, provided, however, that such emergency procurements shall be made with such competition as is practicable under the circumstances. A written determination of the basis for the emergency and for the selection of the particular contractor shall be included in the contract file. As soon as practicable, a record of the emergency procurement shall be made and shall set forth the contractor's name, the amount and type of the contract, a listing of the supply or contractual service procured under this contract, and the number of the purchase order, if any. The city commission must be notified, after the fact, of such procurements in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) at the next scheduled commission meeting. In any event any increase over the original amount of an emergency procurement reported to the city commission exceeding ten (10) percent shall be reported to the city commission to be noted for the record.
