



- Adjust as needed


Initial budgets are established during the Planning Phase while cost estimates are periodically adjusted during the Design Phase.

Potential Cost Savings

• Seeking the waiver of permitting fees as a cost savings measure.

Reasons for Change

- Scope Expansion
 - Additional Amenities
- Unforeseen Conditions
 - Environmental Contamination and Soil Conditions
- Escalation of Material Prices
- FEMA Flood Elevation Changes

- Phase in certain amenities over time (i.e. Phase II boardwalk, landscaping, walkway lighting, etc.)
- Analyze Alternative Materials and Construction Methods
- Reduction of Scope
- Explore Additional Grant Opportunities
 - Currently pending grant applications \$11,843,112

Cost Management Process



 The process of establishing the policies, procedures, and documentation for planning, managing, expending, and controlling project costs.

Estimated Costs

• The process of estimating costs for project activities.

Determine Budget

• The process of aggregating individual activity or work package cost in order to establish the cost baseline.



• The process of monitoring the status of the project to update the project costs and managing change to the cost baseline




Project Delivery Method Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR)

Two-Part Construction Contract:


- 1. Preconstruction Services
- Construction Services Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP)

Incentives:

- 1. Cost savings
- 2. Change order mitigation
- 3. Ability to "fast-track" project




