NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Oakland Park is issuing a request for proposals (applications) from non-profit organizations serving residents of Oakland Park to be funded from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Broward County Housing Finance and Community Development Division for the 44th Program Year (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019) as follows:

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): Approximately \$30,000 may be available for up to two (2) non-profit organizations, minimum amount of \$15,000 each, serving the City of Oakland residents. This funding availability is not guaranteed.

The City is also considering a City Capital Improvement Project to be funded from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Broward County Housing Finance and Community Development Division for the 44th Program Year (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019)

FINAL PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL

The final recommendation for Capital project funding will be considered by the City of Oakland Park Commissioners on February 21, 2018 at 6:30 PM, and for the nonprofit funding on March 21st at 6:30, in the City Commission Chambers, located at 3650 NE 12th Avenue, Oakland Park, Florida.

BROWARD COUNTY'S SUBMITTAL DATE

Once the City of Oakland Park selects the projects for funding, the applications will be submitted by the City to the Broward County Housing Finance and Community Development Division, 110 NE 3rd Street, Third Floor, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, on or before 12:00 Noon, EST on Monday, March 5, 2018. Broward County staff will review and evaluate all submitted applications during the period from March 2018 through May 2018 before presenting the overall CDBG/ESG/HOME Action Plan to the Board of County Commissioners for their consideration sometime during May 2018.
