Dear Mr. Moskowitz,

It was a pleasure to meet with you and Mr. John Noble on Friday, February 9th, 2018 to discuss our mutual interests. I trust you gained an understanding of the City's position relative to the nonperformance of Ashbritt in the days and weeks subsequent to Hurricane Irma's impact. It is my understanding gained as a result of our discussion that Ashbritt agrees going forward for the duration of the existing contract to stage four (4) trucks and six (6) trailers in the City of Oakland Park for the duration of the entire hurricane emergency and to be operational within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt of notice from the City to proceed. The four (4) trucks and six (6) trailers* would be required to participate in any recovery efforts necessitated after the declaration of an emergency. In addition to the placement of the four (4) trucks and six (6) trailers, Ashbritt would be required to post with the City on or before June 1st of each successive year, a performance bond in the amount of \$10,000.00 that would be drawn down in the event Ashbritt failed to respond to an emergency situation in the City. In the event the City did not draw down on the bond it would be released on or before December 31st of each year.

It is requested that you provide confirmation of this arrangement and provide specifics as to the types of vehicles to be placed in the City on or before June 1, 2018 and a suitable location for the vehicles.

The City looks forward to a continuing relationship with Ashbritt that will benefit the interests of the City's residents. Thank you very much for your anticipated cooperation.
