RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL OPERATING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been prepared estimating expenses and revenues of the City of Oakland Park, Florida for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad

valorem levy, and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has met and considered the recommendations of City staff relative to the proposed budget and the proposed millage rate to be levied to carry on the government of the City for the ensuing year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The proposed millage rate necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the preliminary budget for the fiscal year is hereby set at 6.0880_mills.

SECTION 3. The preliminary millage rate will be reflected in the Broward County Appraiser TRIM notice, which will serve to notify all property owners of a public hearing to be held on the 11th day of September 2019 at 6:30pm for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative budget and millage to be presented at that time. This meeting is for the purpose of setting a Tentative Tax Levy and Tentative Budget. Subsequently, on the 18th day of September, after being properly advertised in a newspaper published in Broward County, Florida, a second public hearing will be held for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the proposed Final Tax Levy and Budget then adopting the Final Tax Levy and Budget.
