The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby 22 23 ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby 24 incorporated herein. 25 26 **SECTION 2.** In accepting the recommendation of City staff, the City 27 Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the 28 proper City officials to execute an agreement with Bergeron Emergency Services to 29 accept vegetative debris from disaster related damage transported from the City of 30 Oakland Park to Bergeron Park of Commerce dumpsite; a copy of the Proposal dated 31 May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". 32 33 **SECTION 3.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and 34 the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict. 35 36 **SECTION 4.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held 37 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such 38 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect 39 the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.
