**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BERGERON EMERGENCY SERVICES TO ACCEPT VEGETATIVE DEBRIS FROM DISASTER RELATED DAMAGE TRANSPORTED FROM THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK TO BERGERON PARK OF COMMERCE DUMPSITE; A COPY OF THE PROPOSAL IS ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to approve and authorize the proper City officials to execute an agreement with Bergeron Emergency Services to accept vegetative debris from disaster related damage transported from the City of Oakland Park to Bergeron Park of Commerce dumpsite.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** In accepting the recommendation of City staff, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the proper City officials to execute an agreement with Bergeron Emergency Services to accept vegetative debris from disaster related damage transported from the City of Oakland Park to Bergeron Park of Commerce dumpsite; a copy of the Proposal dated May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 3.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
