**RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-XXX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THAT \_\_\_\_\_ IS THE MOST RESPONSIVE AND MOST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER TO PROVIDE DEMOLITION AND DEBRIS REMOVAL SERVICES FOR THE DECOMMISSIONED WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; PROVIDING THAT THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICES IN WHICH IS ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the City has sought competitive bids to provide demolition and debris removal services for the decommissioned wastewater treatment plant;

**WHEREAS,** a selection committee comprised of staff members evaluated the bids and has made a recommendation to the City Commission;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida hereby accepts the recommendation as submitted by the City's selection committee and determines that \_\_\_\_\_ is the most responsible and most responsive bidder to provide demolition and debris removal services for the decommissioned wastewater treatment plant.

**SECTION 3.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City official to execute a contract with \_\_\_\_\_ to provide demolition and debris removal services for the decommissioned wastewater treatment plant; a copy of the contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way effecting the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
