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RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE NORTH DIXIE HIGHWAY CORRIDOR PROJECT IDENTIFIED IN THE DRAFT 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization approved the draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan on May 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the North Dixie Highway Corridor project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Prospect Road that will include new multimodal connections for bicyclist and pedestrians, with safe routes connecting neighborhoods, has been identified as a transportation need and is currently a ranked project in the approved draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Oakland Park Commission stating support for the project is required for the project to be included in the final 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park commits to working with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization, the Florida Department of Transportation, and the public to prepare the project for programming in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's Transportation Improvement Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby supports and authorizes the City Clerk to submit this Resolution to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization relative to the North Dixie Highway (SR 811) project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Prospect Road to be included in the final 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

SECTION 3. The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
