RE: Program for Public Information Committee

At the September 18, 2019 City Commission meeting, the Commission passed a resolution establishing a Program for Public Information (PPI) Committee as part of the City's National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System (CRS) efforts.

Pursuant to Community Rating System (CRS) guidelines the Program for Public Information (PPI) Committee shall consist of a minimum of five (5) people to include at a minimum (membership can be resident and business stakeholders and/or staff, so long as staff does not make up a majority of the committee). The following are the selected Committee members:

- Oakland Park Floodplain Manager Albert Carbon
- Oakland Park outreach and publicity staff David Rafter
- A stakeholder of the City with insurance industry credentials -Veronica Velez, Oakland Park State Farm
- Resident and business owner David Bowles
- Resident Scott Burnett

In addition, Peter Schwarz, Assistant Director of Community and Economic Development will serve as a non-voting staff liaison to the PPI Committee.
