## **ORDINANCE NO. O-2019-XXX**

 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 2-71 ENTITLED "SCHOOL ADVISORY BOARD"; PROVIDING FOR ONE (1) ALTERNATE MEMBER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission deems it appropriate and in the best interests of the residents of Oakland Park to amend provisions of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances by specifically amending Section 2-71 entitled "School Advisory Board" to provide for one (1) alternate member;

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby amends Chapter 2, Section 2-71 entitled "School Advisory Board" of the Code of Ordinances to provide as follows:

Sec. 2-71. - School advisory board.

- (a) The city commission of the City of Oakland Park hereby creates a school advisory board consisting of eight (8) members. The purpose and duties of the school advisory board are to advise the city commission on all issues relating to educational matters which will impact the quality of education for city residents, or which will impact education facilities located within the city. Furthermore, the board shall endeavor to insure that all community interests are identified as key intended goals and therefore, actively engaged in the formulation of a community partnership so as to insure heightened participation by all individuals that make up the Oakland Park community.
- (b) The school advisory board will be made up of eight (8) members consisting of citizens and residents of Oakland Park. Each member of the city commission shall be afforded the opportunity to appoint one (1) member to the board and by consensus appoint one (1) alternate board member. The city manager shall be afforded the opportunity to appoint one (1) member and the board shall, as a whole, appoint an at large member who shall be a student attending either a high school or middle school

located in the city. No member shall be an employee of the Broward County School Board. All appointments shall be subject to ratification by the city commission. Each member shall serve for a term of one (1) year and the city commission shall appoint new members at the first city commission meeting held in the month of August for each year. Attendance policy for members of this board is governed by section 2-72 of this Code of Ordinances.
The board shall meet no less than every other month and shall make its recommendations to the city commission to assist the commission in gaining an understanding of the goals and objectives adopted by the Broward County School Board from time to time which would affect the operation and management of the five (5) public schools located within the city.
<b>SECTION 3.</b> If any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such constitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affecting validity of the other provisions of this Ordinance.
<b>SECTION 4</b> . All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are reby repealed to the extent of such conflicts.
SECTION 5. It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Oakland k, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code Ordinances of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, and the Sections of this ordinance y be renumbered, re-lettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section," rticle," or such other word or phrase in order to accomplish such intention.
<b>SECTION 6.</b> This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and adoption by City Commission of the City of Oakland Park.
