WHEREAS, this past summer was the City's 23rd year to participate in the Summer Food Program, where 9,879 free hot lunches and 11,125 snacks were provided from June 5 to August 13, to all children under the age of 18 at three locations: Collins Community Center, North Andrews Gardens Recreation Center and Spiher Recreation Center.
