The City of Oakland Park Ordinance O-2017-011, requiring pre-existing, non-conforming outdoor storage facilities to provide vision obscuring walls or fencing around their storage yards, took effect July 3, 2020. We initially contacted you regarding this shortly after the code provision was enacted three years ago.

We understand that these are challenging times; therefore, we are providing non-compliant businesses one hundred and twenty (120) days to provide a written plan outlining how your business is preparing to achieve compliance. City staff is happy to sit and review it. Please submit your plan directly to me, Donald Jay Quier at <a href="Donaldq@oaklandparkfl.gov">Donaldq@oaklandparkfl.gov</a> by November 6, 2020. Failure to submit a written plan by November 6th will result in the City moving forward with enforcement of the Ordinance requirements. The Ordinance provides for penalties of up to \$250.00 per day.
