WHEREAS, this observance encourages children to lead a more active lifestyle to combat the issues of childhood obesity, diabetes, and hypertension; and

WHEREAS, by discovering our public lands, kids across the country are learning about park stewardship, outdoor recreation, STEM, and history; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has limited our ability to interact with our beloved national, local, and state parks this year and therefore, will not be promoting "special" park events, but instead encouraging people nationwide to celebrate the day at local parks and public lands with their household groups or established COVID "bubbles" focusing on close-to-home outdoor spaces and experiences.
