## 1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-06** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF 4 HILLSBORO BEACH, FLORIDA, EXPRESSING ITS SUPPORT OF 5 THE BROWARD COUNTY AUDIT OF THE ANIMAL CARE AND 6 ADOPTION DIVISION, REPORT NO. 21-05, DATED DECEMBER 16, 7 2020; PROVIDING FOR ITS SUPPORT OF THE IMPLEMENTATION 8 OF GUIDELINES AND BEST PRACTICES BY THE ANIMAL CARE 9 AND ADOPTION DIVISION WITH THE GOAL OF PROVIDING 10 BETTER CARE FOR THE DOGS AND CATS MAINTAINED AT THE 11 SHELTER; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR 12 SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 13 14 15 WHEREAS, the Broward County Adoption Shelter is located at 2400 SW 42nd Street 16 Fort Lauderdale, FL 33312 and is maintained and operated by Broward County through the 17 Animal Care and Adoption Division for the purposes of providing care of dogs and cats; 18 19 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners requested that an audit of the overall 20 operation of the Broward County Shelter be undertaken by the Broward County Office of the 21 County Auditor; and 22 23 WHEREAS, on December 16, 2020, the Office of the County Auditor issued its audit 24 that among other things, the operation of the Shelter does not consistently adhere to best 25 practices and laws, and that the programs and processes utilized at the Broward County Shelter 26 are not operating effectively; and 27 28 WHEREAS, the audit identifies that 78% of the calls from the public, the majority of 29 which relate directly to interest in the animals, go unanswered; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the audit indicates that the Broward County Shelter is understaffed by 32 33% and needs to increase staffing by 30-36 full-time employees; and 33 34 WHEREAS, the audit identifies that the use of volunteers has been eliminated for 35 months, and recommends that it be reinstated and efficiently administered; and 36 37 WHEREAS, the operation of the Shelter results in animals in interior kennels are left in 38 the dark for 14-18 hours a day; and 39 40 WHEREAS, the current operation at the Shelter relative to animal confinement (kennels/cages) fails to meet industry standards, which requires a minimum of two feet of space 41 42 between defecation, feeding and resting areas for felines and soft bedding for canines; and 43 44 WHEREAS, the Broward County Shelter does not meet "no-kill" guidelines 45 established by Broward County and statistics for October 2020 show 115 animal deaths. 27
