- WHEREAS, The City of Oakland Park needs to consolidate its fee schedule for
   the benefit of applicants and to facilitate adjustments necessary from time to time to reflect
   current City costs; and
- WHEREAS, Some current fees for various penalties are specifically embedded in
   sections of the Code of Ordinances while others are found in fee schedules adopted by
   Resolution such that these different locations make fees difficult to find and update; and
- WHEREAS, the City Commission finds it to be in the best interest of the residents
  and property owners of the City to update the Code of Ordinances with the amended text
  herein.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

26 <u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as
 27 being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance upon adoption thereof.

<u>Section 2</u>. CHAPTER 21 - TRAFFIC, SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE II. –
 STOPING, STANDING AND PARKING, DIVISION I - GENERALLY, SECTION 21 46.2 FINES, PENALTIES, AND REMOVAL is hereby amended as follows:

31 Sec. 21-46.2. - Fines, penalties and removal.

(a) Violation of parking regulations shall be punishable by a fine of <u>an amount</u>
 established by Resolution approved by the City Commission ten dollars (\$10.00) if
 paid within ten (10) calendar days, and <u>of a higher amount established by Resolution</u>
 approved by the City Commission twenty dollars (\$20.00) if paid after ten (10) days

1 2 3		but prior to initiation of prosecution in county court, except as provided in subsection (d) herein. Failure to pay such fines or any other violation of the parking regulations shall be punishable as provided by law.
4 5 6	(b)	Any unattended vehicle creating a traffic hazard or found in a restricted parking zone as set forth in section 21-34.2 may, in addition to the fines provided herein, be removed and the expense of said removal be charged to the owner of the vehicle.
7 8	(c)	Violations of parking regulations in designated handicapped parking spaces shall be punishable by the maximum fine as allowed by state law.
9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16	(d)	Violations of parking regulations on public or private property in a space which has been designated as a fire zone or fire lane shall be punishable by a fine of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) an amount established by Resolution approved by the City Commission if paid within ten (10) calendar days, and <u>of a higher amount established by Resolution</u> <u>approved by the City Commission</u> thirty dollars (\$30.00) if paid after ten (10) days but prior to initiation of prosecution in county court. Failure to pay such fine or any other violation of the parking regulations shall be punishable as provided by law.
