R-2021-XXX** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF 4 5 OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE 6 MILLAGE RATE OF FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL 7 **OPERATING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR** BEGINNING 8 OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; 9 PROVIDING FOR **SEVERABILITY;** PROVIDING FOR 10 **CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 11 12 WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared estimating expenses and 13 revenues of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, for the ensuing year, with detailed 14 information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad valorem levy, 15 and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount to be appropriated for 16 the ensuing year; and 17 18 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission has met and considered the recommendations, 19 the suggested tentative budget, and the tentative millage to be levied to carry on the 20 government of the City for the ensuing year; 21 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE 23 **CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:** 24 25 **<u>SECTION 1</u>**. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby 26 ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby 27 incorporated herein. 28 29 **SECTION 2.** The tentative operating millage rate necessary to be levied against 30 ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida, 31 to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be 32 sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the tentative budget for the fiscal year is 33 hereby set at _____ mills. 34 35 **SECTION 3.** The tentative millage levy for voted debt service necessary 36 to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of 37 Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for 38 General Obligation Bonds for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills. 39

1 **SECTION 4.** The millage referred to in the preceding Sections are hereby levied 2 for the following purposes: 3 4 Purpose Mills 5 General Fund Operating Levy 6 General Obligation Debt Service Levy 7 8 SECTION 5. The Operating Millage adopted herein is lesser/greater than the 9 rolled-back rate of _____ mills computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section 200.065, 10 Florida Statutes, 2002, as amended) by ______. This percentage shall be known as the percentage decrease/increase in property taxes adopted by the City. 11 12 13 **SECTION 6.** The tentative budget advertisement in compliance with Florida 14 Statute 200.065 shall be published in one issue of a newspaper published in Broward 15 County, Florida, and at the same time the public will be notified of a public hearing to be held at 6:30 p.m. on the 22nd day of September, 2021, in City Commission Chambers of 16 City Hall, 3650 NE 12th Avenue, Oakland Park, Florida, for the purpose of hearing 17 18 objections or criticisms of the tentative budget and millage. This meeting is for the 19 purpose of setting a Final Tax Levy and Final Budget. To support the public's continued safety concerns, public comments may also be provided virtually (limit 4 minutes) by 20 21 registering by 5:00 p.m. with Zoom Webinar ID: 845 2902 8362, or by contacting the 22 City Clerk's office at 954-630-4300. Written public comments (limit 250 words) can be 23 submitted for the record to publiccomments@oaklandparkfl.gov by 5:00 p.m. the day of 24 the meeting. 25 26 **SECTION 7.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held 27 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such 28 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and shall in no way 29 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. 30 31 **SECTION 8.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are 32 hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. 33 34 **SECTION 9.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and 35 adoption. 36
