RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park desires to support Broward County’s goal of achieving Closes Unit Response (CUR) for life threatening emergency responses through the use of technology and public safety standard operating procedures; and

WHEREAS, the CUR allows for Broward County Regional 911 Communication Centers to identify the exact location of Broward County Fire Rescue Vehicles utilizing Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) technology and state of the art mapping systems; and

WHEREAS, by installing GPS and broadband capable mobile data terminals in each fire rescue frontline emergency vehicle coupled with 911 dispatch and mobile mapping software, vehicles will be able to respond to incidents more quickly; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, the Broward County residents voted by charter amendment to provide for the establishment and funding of communications infrastructure for fire and emergency medical services to facilitate CUR for life-threatening emergencies and support for regional specialty teams; and

WHEREAS, by and through this Agreement, the Parties intend to provide for

1 automatic aid via closest unit response for life-threatening emergencies as defined
2 herein as Exhibit A, and as part of the normal day-to-day operations of all of the Parties
3 while not providing such aid to subsidize normal day-to-day operations; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the stated purpose and intent of this Agreement is for the Parties
5 to cooperate with each other on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide
6 services and facilities that will harmonize geographic, economic, population, and other
7 factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the effective date of the Agreement is on the first day of the first
9 calendar month after execution of this Agreement by each Party; and

10 **WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of staff that Oakland Park execute this
11 Agreement with Broward County, Broward Sheriff's Office and Municipalities; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida deems
13 it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Oakland Park to
14 approve this Agreement (attached hereto as Exhibit A)

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION**
17 **OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:**

19 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby
20 ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby
21 incorporated herein.

23 **SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida,
24 hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate city officials to execute the Regional
25 Interlocal Agreement for Cooperative Fire, Rescue, Emergency Medical Services, and
26 Special Operations Response through Automatic Aid and Closes Unit Response between
27 the City of Tamarac, Broward Sheriff's Office, Broward County and Municipalities. A
28 copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

30 **SECTION 3.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to
31 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.
