WHEREAS, across the country, families and friends of victims have gathered during Domestic Violence Awareness Month to bring awareness to this tragedy and honor their loved ones who lost their lives at the hands of a person they once loved and trusted.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, by the virtue of the authority vested in it by the Charter does hereby authorize the Mayor Jane Bolin to proclaim the month of October as
