MINUTES
SCHOOL ADVISORY BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 23, 2021, 5:30 P.M

The regular meeting of the School Advisory Board of the City of Oakland Park, Florida was called to order at 5:30pm by Board Member Coby King.

Due to COVID-19, precautionary safety measures were in place and access to city facilities was limited to ensure social distancing. The opportunity of public participation has been provided by email or by calling the City Clerk's office.

1. Public Comments

JoeAnn Morejon, Oakland Park Childcare Coordinator with the Parks and Leisure Services Department provided an update on the City's aftercare program and athletic youth programs. The afterschool program began last week at Lloyd Estates Elementary School and offers transportation from Floranada, Oakland Park, and North Andrews Gardens Elementary schools on a first come first service with a limit of 12 students from each school. The program is fee based with scholarship opportunities and doubled enrollment from last year with 49 children registered. Athletic youth programs, football and cheerleading, will begin in September. Depending on safety concerns, the public school holiday programming will begin with first September 16th.

Broward School Board representative Angel Gomez provided an update on various topics including the new interim superintendent is Dr. Vickie Cartwright. School began last week with Mayors, including Mayor Bolin welcomed the students. He provided update on mask mandates and how students can receive academic assistance if they are quarantined. *AskBria* link will be provided which offers online tutoring and homework assistance. He will be sending school enrollment and comparison from last year. Remote learning is not offered now, but Broward Virtual learning is available. Preliminary attendance numbers will be provided to Ms. Burnett to share.

Board member King reported roof construction is ongoing at Oakland Park Elementary, Board Member Naylor reported he spoke with Lloyd Estates Principal Allen who shared they had a “Sneak Peak” event Tuesday, August 17 when parents learned about teachers and school coordination. The annual SAC meeting schedule was provided.

Ms. Burnett reported Floranada Elementary also had a meet and greet August 17th.

Board Chair Donnelly reported due to ceiling collapse at Rickard Middle School, grades 6, 7 and 8 have been temporarily relocated during school construction. Sixth grade has been relocated to William Dandy Middle School, seventh grade is relocated to Lauderdale Lakes Middle School, and eighth grade is relocated to Northeast High School.

4. **Staff Liaison Report**

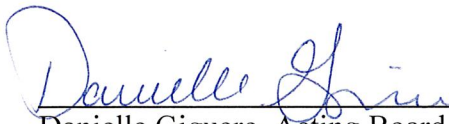
Staff Liaison Burnett reported JoeAnn Morejon will be returning as board secretary. She provided an update on Broward County Schools' summer session at North Andrews Gardens as well as the City's modified summer camp program. Staff Liaison Burnett mentioned that some of the special student-related City events are currently on hold due to the County's current 20% COVID transmission rate. She confirmed BSO resource officers are the same as last year as well as number of crossing guards. Ms. Burnett will reach out to Northeast High School for the School Advisory Board's student appointment.
