A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA APPOINTING THREE (3) MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE PROGRAM FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION BOARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2021, the City Commission adopted ordinance O-2021-018 establishing a Program for Public Information Board as part of the City's participation in the Community rating system for the National Flood Insurance Program to help property owners protect their properties from flood events; and

WHEREAS, the Board shall consist of five members and be appointed for a two-year term; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to appoint three (3) members to the Program for Public Information Board for a two (2) year term;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida hereby appoints the following three (3) members to serve on the Program for Public Information Board:

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
