RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2023 FORD EXPLORER POLICE INTERCEPTOR VEHICLE FOR THE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT FROM DUVAL FLORIDA PIGGYBACKING THE TERMS OF FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION (FSA) CONTRACT FSA 20-VEL28.0 AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SAFETY LIGHTING FROM STROBES-R-US; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to approve and authorize the purchase of a 2023 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor vehicle for Fire Rescue from Duval Florida piggybacking the terms of Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) Contract FSA 20-VEL28.0 and to authorize the purchase of safety lighting from Strobes-R-Us.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2023 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor vehicle for Fire Rescue from Duval Florida piggybacking the terms of Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) Contract FSA 20-VEL28.0 in an amount not to exceed \$36,079 and authorizes the purchase of safety lighting from Strobes-R-Us in an amount not to exceed \$33,053.00.

SECTION 3. The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
