In accepting the recommendation of City staff, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the 26 27 proper City officials to execute an Agreement for Fleet Maintenance and Repair Services 28 with Truck Masters, Inc. piggybacking the terms of the City of Deerfield Beach Contract 29 RFQ #20-17-PC in an amount not to exceed the budgeted availability within the Public 30 Works Fleet Management Division; a copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit 31 "A". 32 33 **SECTION 3.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and 34 the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict. 35 36 **SECTION 4.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held 37 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such 38 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect 39 the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution. 40 41 SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its 42 passage and adoption. 43
