PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, established in 1957, the City of Oakland Park will commemorate its Annual Youth Day event on Saturday March 5, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this long time Oakland Park tradition celebrates the vitality and promise of young lives, academic and civic accomplishments of local youth, and encourages mentorship between students and successful professionals; and

WHEREAS, Broward County's longest-running parade is themed *Where Everyone Can Be A Superhero* led by elected officials, community groups, local schools, and athletic teams; and

WHEREAS, this year's Youth Day Parade Grand Marshalls are our education heroes - principals from Oakland Park Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Day parade begins at 10:00 a.m. at Jaco Pastorius Park and proceeds south on Dixie Highway, turns west on NE 38th Street, north along NE 5th Avenue and finishes at the Wimberly Field Athletic Complex.; and

WHEREAS, Youth Day – an all-day event - promises fun for the entire family with carnival-style activities, entertainment and a spectacular fireworks display.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in it by the Charter, does hereby authorize Mayor Michael Carn to proclaim Saturday, March 5, 2022, as the
