A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA APPOINTING THREE (3) MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE BEAUTIFICATION ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Beautification Board consists of seven (7) members who serve a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, there presently exists three (3) vacancies on the Board and City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to appoint three (3) members to serve on the Beautification Advisory Board so as to provide for a full complement of seven (7) members;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.
