## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR CROSSING GUARD SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park, a Florida municipal corporation (the "CITY") and WATERFIELD FLORIDA STAFFING, LLC D/B/A STAFFING CONNECTION (the "CONTRACTOR"), a staffing company located in Broward County, Florida, entered into an Agreement for Crossing Guard Services on September 3, 2020, resolution R-2020-105.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2020, Florida voters approved Amendment 2, which amends Florida's constitution to gradually increase the state's minimum wage to \$15.00 an hour by the year 2026.

WHEREAS, as of January 1, 2021, the minimum wage increased \$.09 of \$8.65 per hour, as scheduled. On September 30, 2021, the minimum wage will rise to \$10.00 per hour (\$1.35 per hour increase). Every September 30 following, the minimum wage will increase \$1.00 per hour through 2026.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2021, in order to comply with the Florida Minimum Wage mandate, the CONTRACTOR requested an increase to the current contract rate from \$11.69 per hour to \$13.52 per hour, effective September 30, 2021, through the remainder of the initial contract term which expires July 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, the CITY desires to maintain its Agreement with Staffing Connection for the initial contract term at a contract rate that is agreeable to all parties and; therefore, approves the first requested increase through July 31, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, the CITY and CONTRACTOR do agree to enter into this first amendment to the Agreement:
