The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and 31 hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto 32 33 are hereby incorporated herein. 34 35 **SECTION 2.** The proposed operating millage rate necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida 36 37 to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the preliminary budget for the fiscal year is 38 39 hereby set at _____ mills.

SECTION 3. The Operating Millage adopted herein is greater than the rolledback rate of 5.2464 mills computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section 200.065, Florida
Statutes, 2002, as amended) by <u>11.60</u>%. The percentage shall be known as the
percentage increase in property taxes adopted by the City.

SECTION 4. The millage levy for voted debt service, Series 2020, necessary to
be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of
Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for
General Obligation Bonds for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

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SECTION 5. The millage levy for voted debt service, Series 2022, necessary to
 be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of
 Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for
 General Obligation Bonds for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

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SECTION 6. The proposed millage rates will be reflected in the Broward 15 County Appraiser TRIM notice, which will serve to notify all property owners of a 16 public hearing to be held on the 7th day of September 2022 at 6:30pm for the purpose of 17 hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative budget and millage to be presented at 18 that time. This meeting is for the purpose of setting a Tentative Tax Levy and 19 Subsequently, on the 21st day of September 2022, after being 20 Tentative Budget. properly advertised in a newspaper published in Broward County, Florida, a second 21 22 public hearing will be held for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the proposed Final Tax Levy and Budget then adopting the Final Tax Levy and Budget. 23

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25 **SECTION 7.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to 26 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

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28 SECTION 8. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be
29 and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

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SECTION 9. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.
