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WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been prepared estimating expenses and revenues of the City of Oakland Park, Florida for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad valorem levy, and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The proposed operating millage rate necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the preliminary budget for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

1 **SECTION 3.** The Operating Millage adopted herein is greater than the rolled-
2 back rate of 5.2464 mills computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section 200.065, Florida
3 Statutes, 2002, as amended) by 11.60%. The percentage shall be known as the
4 percentage increase in property taxes adopted by the City.

5 **SECTION 4.** The millage levy for voted debt service, **Series 2020**, necessary to
6 be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of
7 Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for
8 General Obligation Bonds for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.
9

10 **SECTION 5.** The millage levy for voted debt service, **Series 2022**, necessary to
11 be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of
12 Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for
13 General Obligation Bonds for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.
14

15 **SECTION 6.** The proposed millage rates will be reflected in the Broward
16 County Appraiser TRIM notice, which will serve to notify all property owners of a
17 public hearing to be held on the 7th day of September 2022 at 6:30pm for the purpose of
18 hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative budget and millage to be presented at
19 that time. This meeting is for the purpose of setting a Tentative Tax Levy and
20 Tentative Budget. Subsequently, on the 21st day of September 2022, after being
21 properly advertised in a newspaper published in Broward County, Florida, a second
22 public hearing will be held for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the
23 proposed Final Tax Levy and Budget then adopting the Final Tax Levy and Budget.
24

25 **SECTION 7.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to
26 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.
27

28 **SECTION 8.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be
29 and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
30

31 **SECTION 9.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held
32 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, unconstitutional
33 or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the
34 other provisions of this Resolution.
35

36 **SECTION 10.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its
37 passage and adoption.
