20 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby
21 ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby
22 incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute a Work Authorization with Miller, Legg & Associates, Inc. for phase 1 engineering design services for the NE 13th Avenue Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed \$145,250. The Work Authorization is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

30 **SECTION 3.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to
31 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

33 **SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and
34 the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

38 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect
