The Work 28 Authorization is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". 29 30 **SECTION 3.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to 31 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution. 32 33 **SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and 34 the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict. 35 36 **SECTION 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held 37 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such 38 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect 39 the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution. 40 41 SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its 42 passage and adoption. 43
