**RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-XXX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS CULTURAL FACILITIES PROGRAM REQUESTING \$500,000 FOR THE OPEN-AIR SEATING AND PERFORMANCE SPACE AT CITY PARK AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING AN AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 AS THE CITY’S REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland Park has the opportunity to apply for funding in the amount of \$500,000 for the Cultural Facilities Program project, the Open-Air Seating and Performance Space at City Park, with the stipulation of 2 to 1 matching funds; and

**WHEREAS**, funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 necessary for the required match, will be available on July 1, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby authorizes an expenditure of \$1,000,000 to be available by July 1, 2023, for required matching funds for a grant application to the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs in quest for funding the Open-Air Seating and Performance Space at City Park project.

**SECTION 3.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

**SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.
