SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR BUILDING INSPECTION AND PLAN REVIEW

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park, a Florida municipal corporation (the "City") and C.A.P. Government, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "Contractor") entered into that certain Agreement for Building Inspection and Plan Review Services dated September 11, 2019 (the "Original Agreement"), and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment to the Original Agreement dated February 2, 2022 in order to provide for the permit technician rate sheet ("First Amendment"); and

- 2. The Original Agreement, as amended is hereby extended for an additional three (3) year period, up to and including September 10, 2025.
- 3. The Proposed Rates as set forth in the Original Agreement, as amended are hereby amended as follows:
