R-2022-XXX** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF 4 OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE 5 BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; DETERMINING AND 6 7 FIXING THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO CARRY ON THE 8 GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR; 9 DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF APPLICABLE FUNDS ON 10 HAND; ESTIMATING RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES FOR 11 ALL FUNDS, EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; 12 PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN 13 EFFECTIVE DATE. 14 15 WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared by the City Manager 16 estimating expenditures and revenues of the City for the ensuing year, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad 17 18 valorem levy, and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount 19 to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the City Commission has met and considered the 22 recommendations, the suggested budget, and the tentative millage to be levied to 23 carry on the government of the City for the ensuing year; 24 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY 26 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT: 27 28 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and 29 hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached 30 hereto are hereby incorporated herein. 31 32 **SECTION 2.** The tentative budget of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, 33 for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, a 34 copy of which is attached hereto, and more particularly set forth in Exhibit "A", is 35 hereby adopted and the appropriations set out therein are hereby made to maintain 36 and carry on the government of the City of Oakland Park, Florida. 37 38 **SECTION 3.** The tentative budget advertisement in conformance with 39 Florida Statute 200.065 shall be published in one issue of a newspaper published 40 in Broward County, Florida, and at the same time the public will be notified of a public hearing to be held on the 21st day of September, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. for the 41 purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative budget and millage. 42
