R-2022-XXX** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF 4 5 OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE 6 RATE OF FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL OPERATING FUND 7 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING 8 SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING 9 FOR CONFLICTS: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 11 WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared estimating expenses 12 and revenues of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, for the ensuing year, with 13 detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad 14 valorem levy, and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount 15 to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the City Commission has met and considered the 18 recommendations, the suggested tentative budget, and the tentative millage to be 19 levied to carry on the government of the City for the ensuing year; 20 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY 22 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT: 23 24 **SECTION 1.** The tentative operating millage rate necessary to be levied 25 against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida, to produce a sufficient sum which together with 26 27 departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made 28 in the tentative budget for the fiscal year is hereby set at mills. 29 30 **SECTION 2.** The tentative millage levy for voted debt service 31 necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to 32 taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of 33 revenues sufficient to pay for General Obligation Bonds Series 2020 for the 34 fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills. 35 36 **SECTION 3.** The tentative millage levy for voted debt service necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to 37 38 taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of 39 revenues sufficient to pay for General Obligation Bonds Series 2022 for the 40 fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

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1 **SECTION 4.** The millage referred to in the preceding Sections are 2 hereby levied for the following purposes: 3 4 Mills Purpose 5 General Fund Operating Levy 6 General Obligation Debt Service Levy, Series 2020 General Obligation Debt Service Levy, Series 2022 7 8 9 **SECTION 5.** The Operating Millage adopted herein is lesser/greater 10 than the rolled-back rate of mills computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, 2002, as amended) by %. This percentage 11 12 shall be known as the percentage decrease/increase in property taxes adopted by 13 the City. 14 15 **SECTION 7.** The tentative budget advertisement in compliance with Florida Statute 200.065 shall be published in one issue of a newspaper published 16 17 in Broward County, Florida, and at the same time the public will be notified of a 18 public hearing to be held at 6:30 p.m. on the 21st day of September, 2022, in City Commission Chambers of City Hall, 3650 NE 12th Avenue, Oakland Park, 19 20 Florida, for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative budget 21 and millage. This meeting is for the purpose of setting a Final Tax Levy and 22 Final Budget. To support the public's continued safety concerns, public comments may also be provided virtually (limit 4 minutes) by registering by 5:00 23 24 p.m. with Zoom Webinar ID: 852 7467 1975, or by contacting the City Clerk's 25 office at 954-630-4300. Written public comments (limit 250 words) can be 26 submitted for the record to publiccomments@oaklandparkfl.gov by 5:00 p.m. the 27 day of the meeting. 28 29 **SECTION 8.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall 30 be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, 31 such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and shall in 32 no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. 33 34 **SECTION 9.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith 35 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. 36 37 **SECTION 10.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage 38 and adoption.
