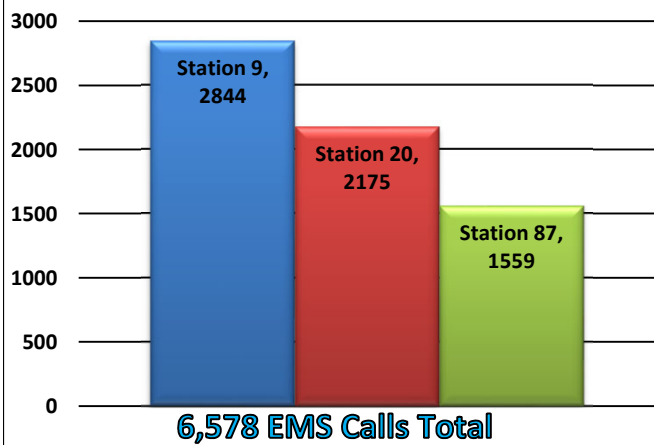

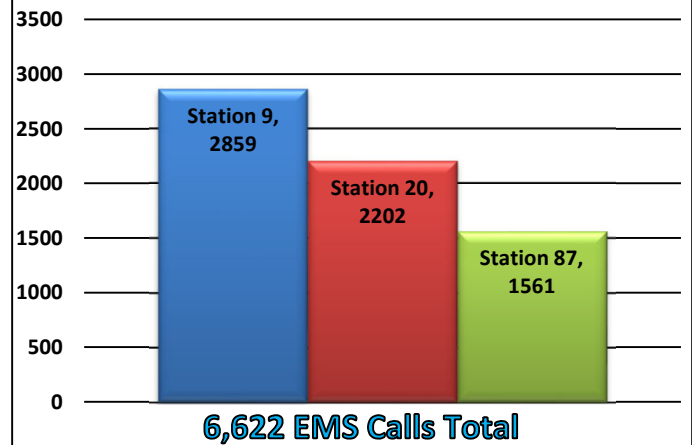

2020-2021**

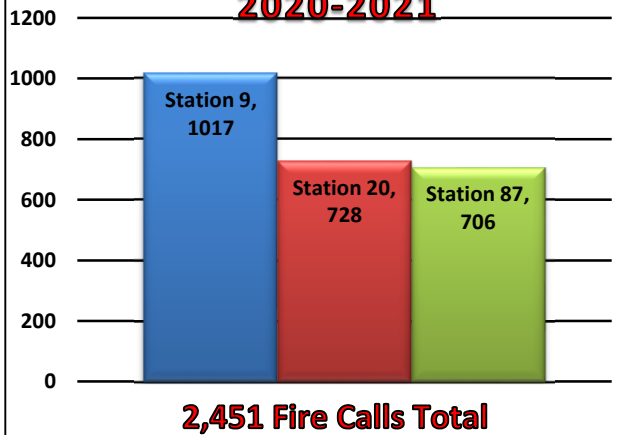

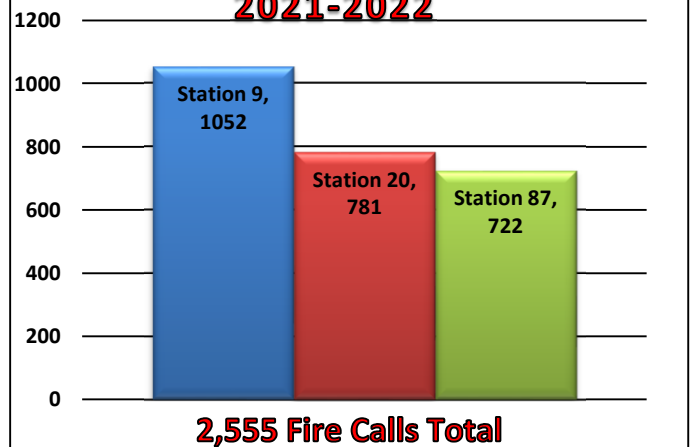

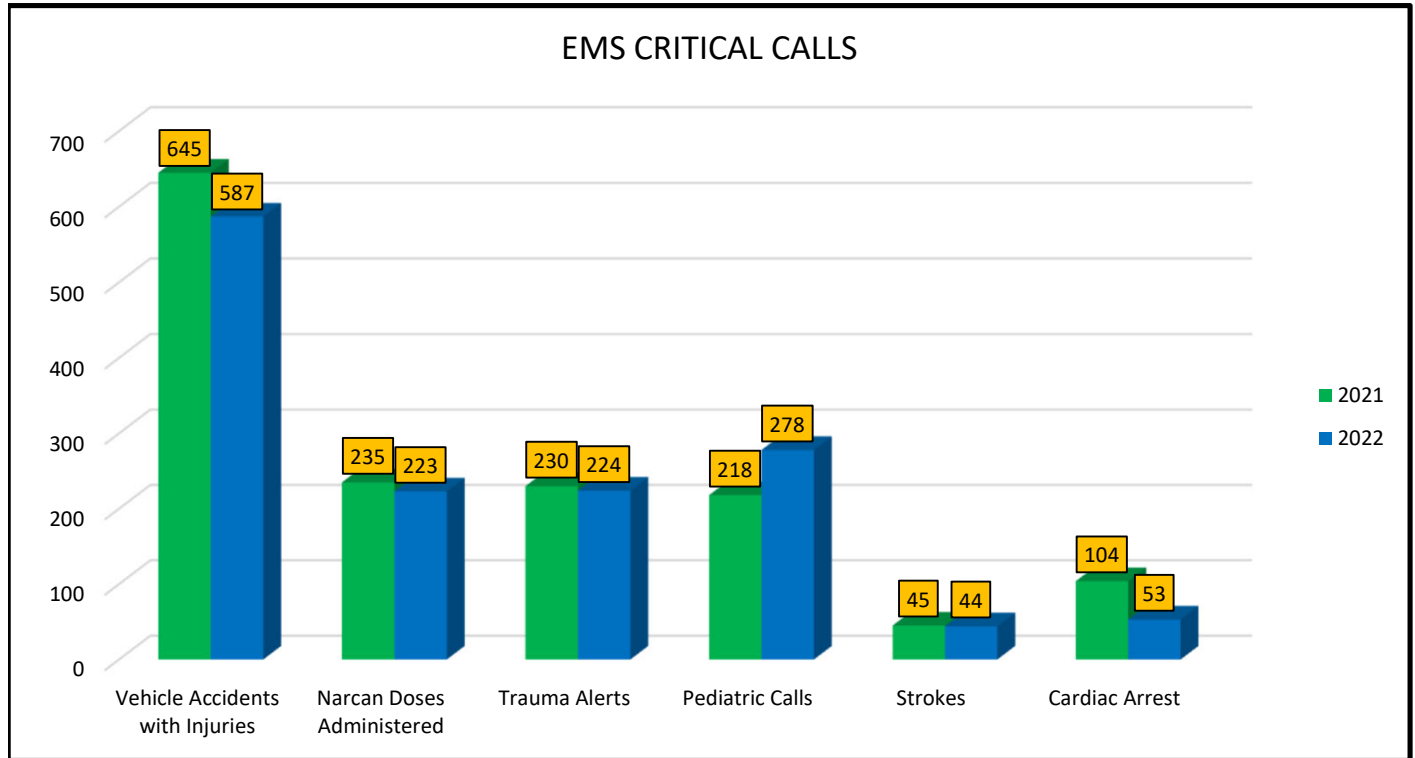

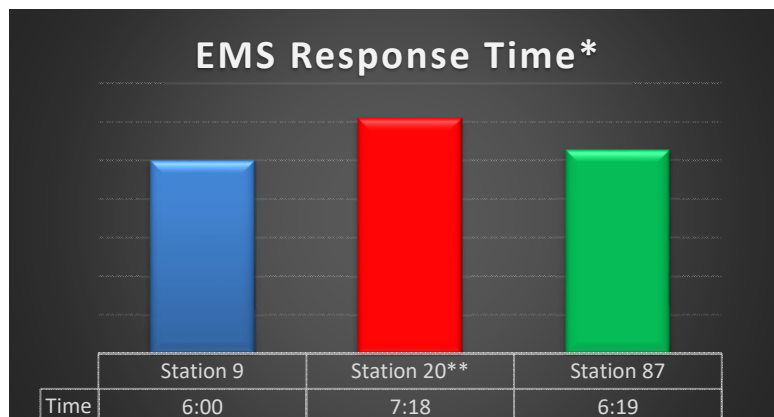

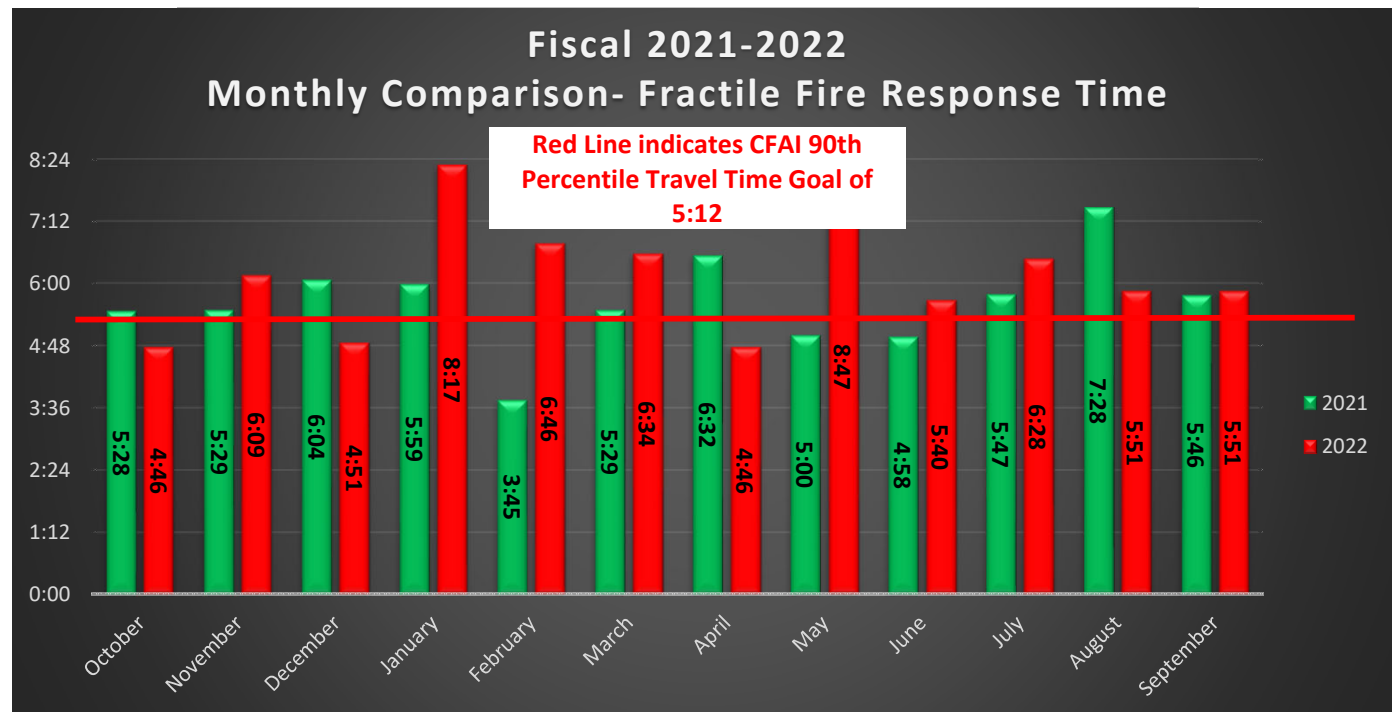
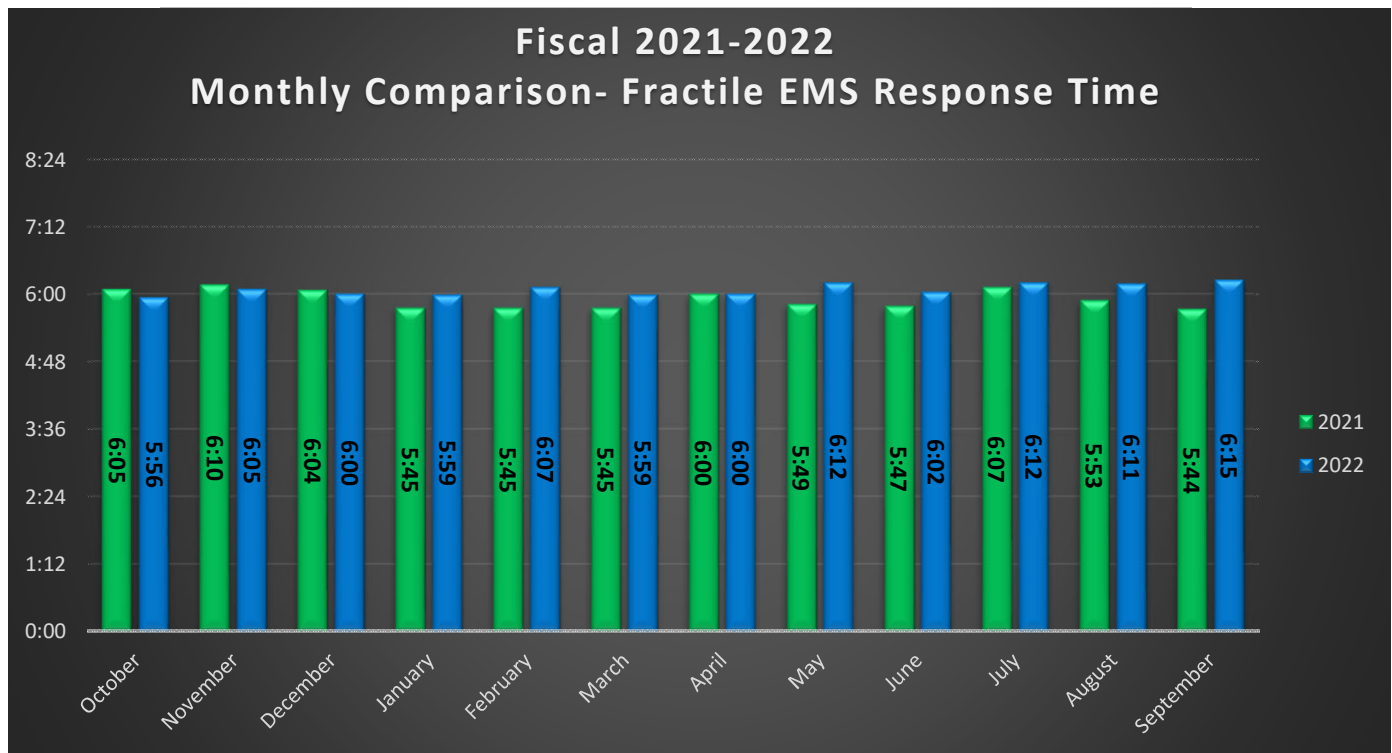
Average Response Times by Station Annual Report, Fiscal 2021-2022



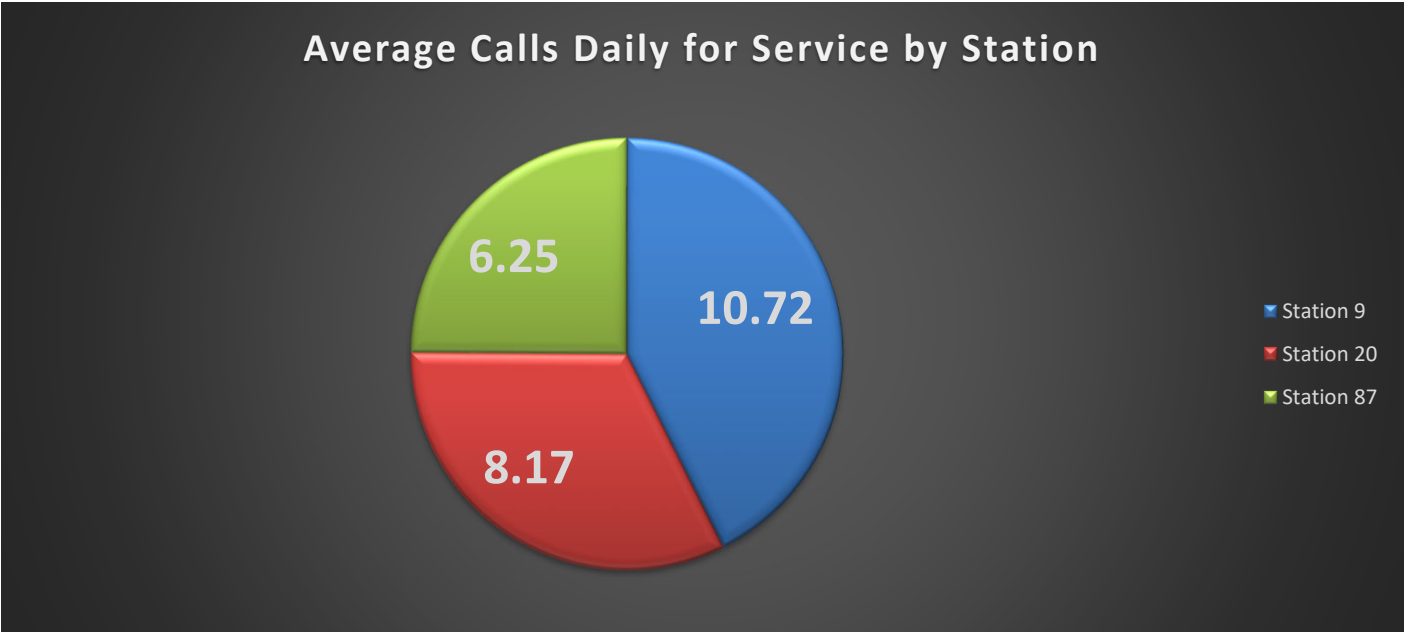
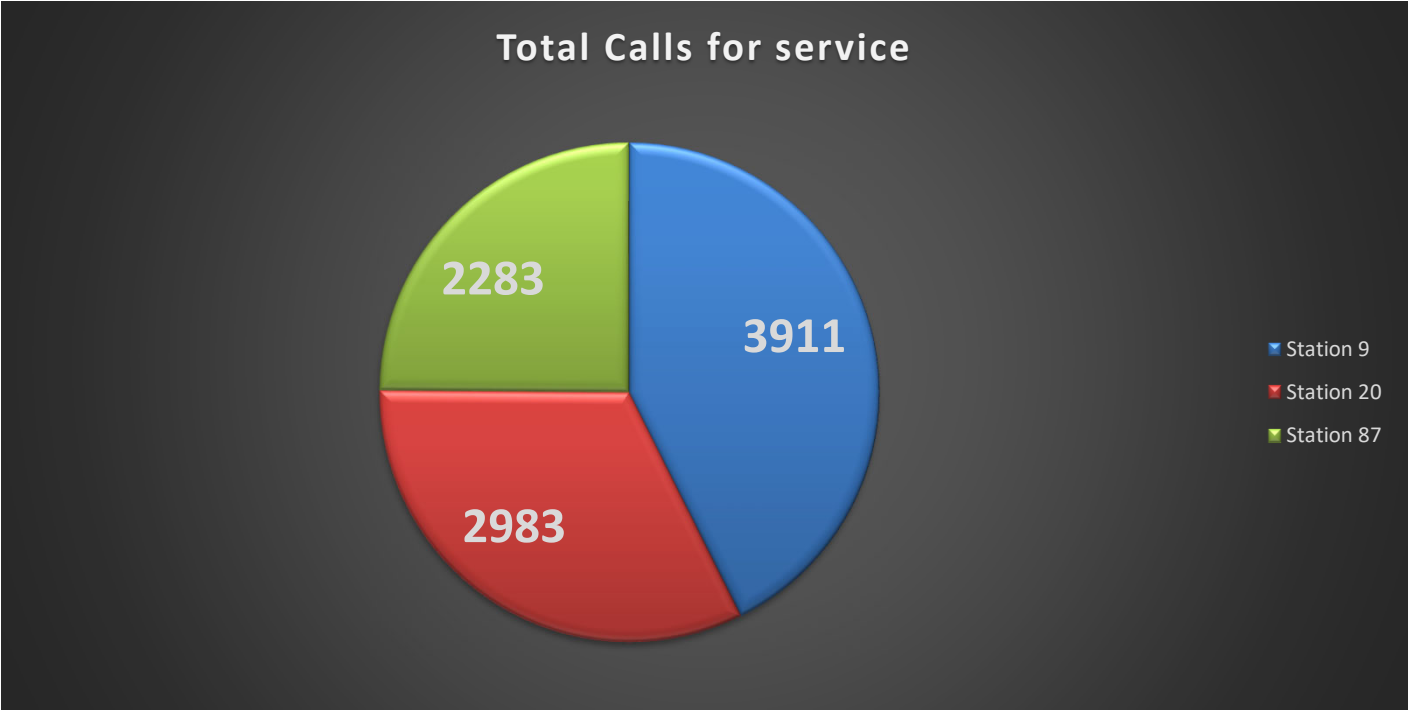

Fractile Response Times Annual Report Fiscal 2021-2022



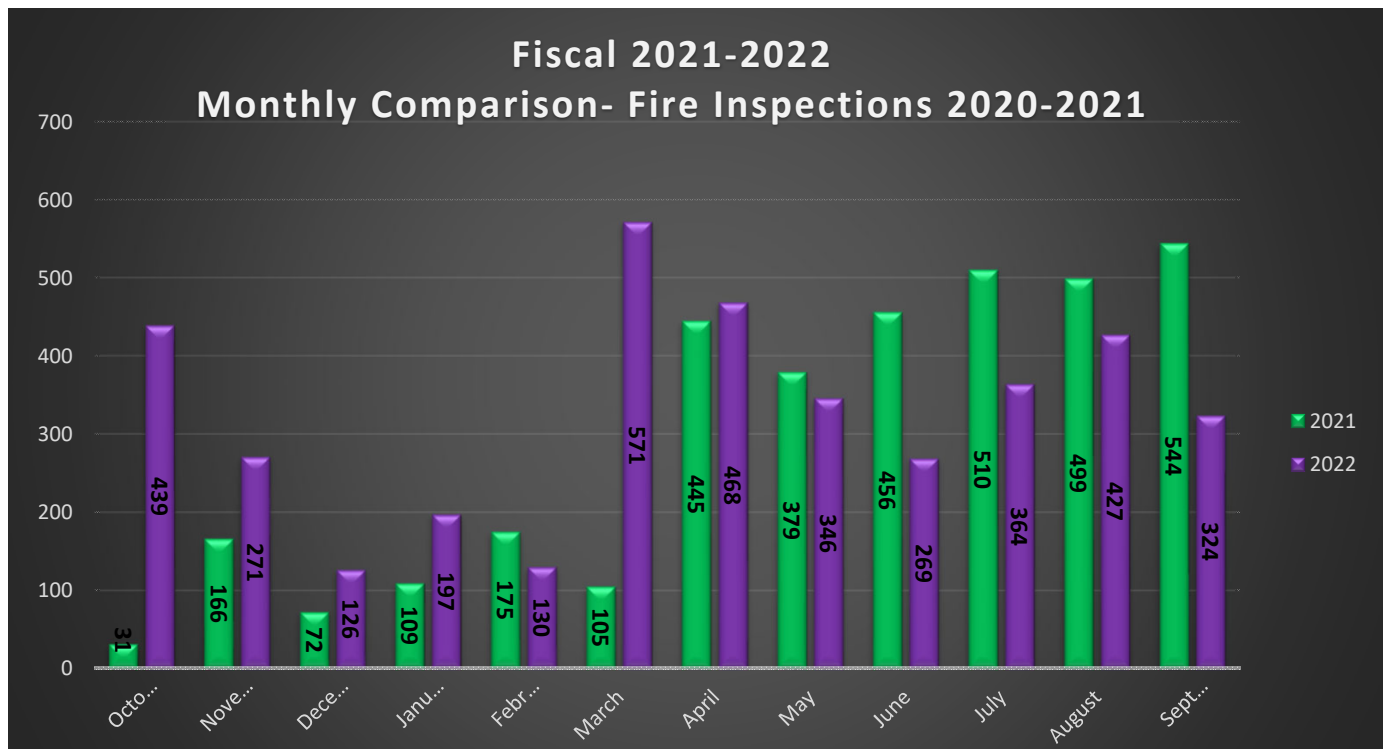

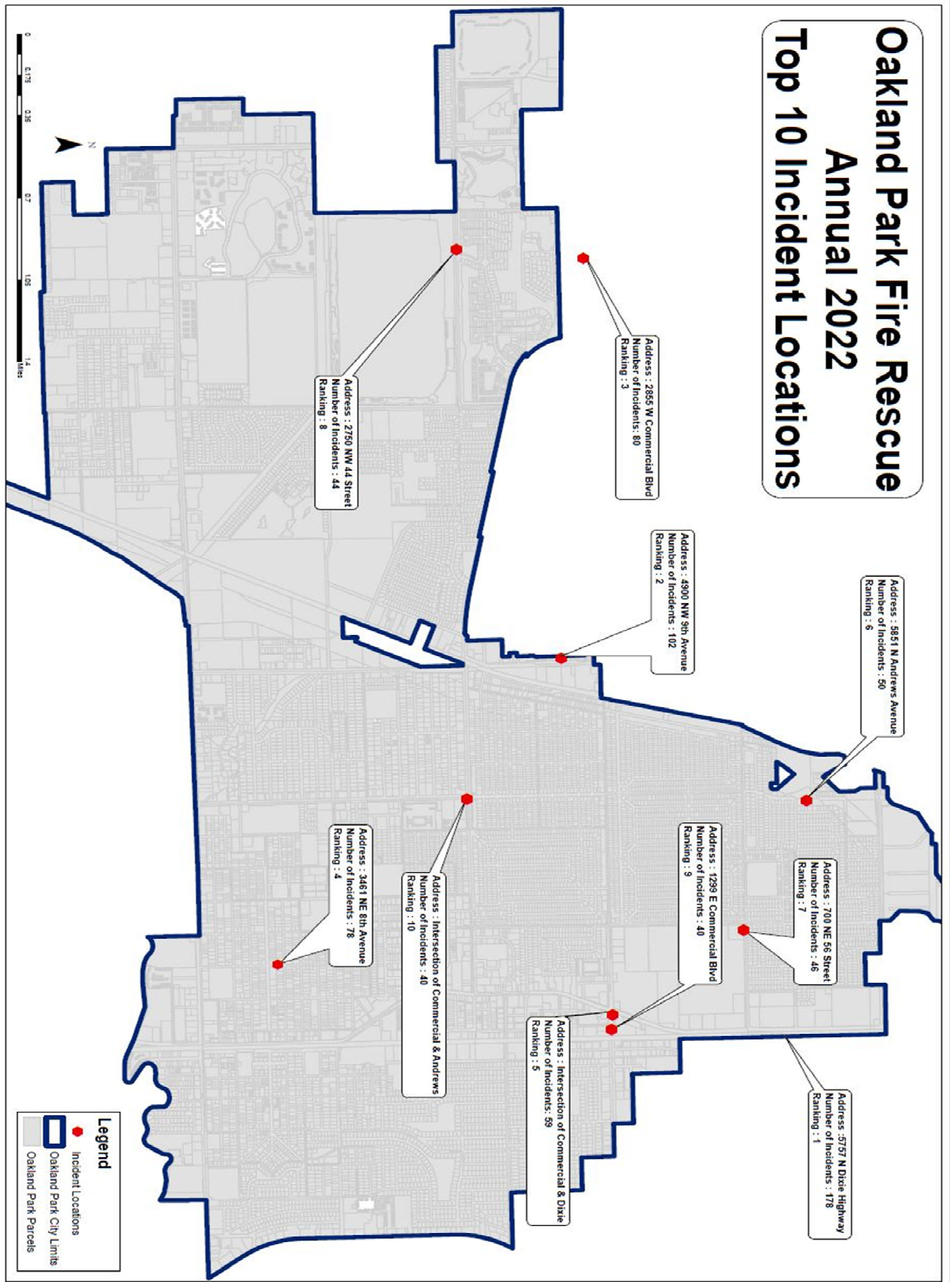

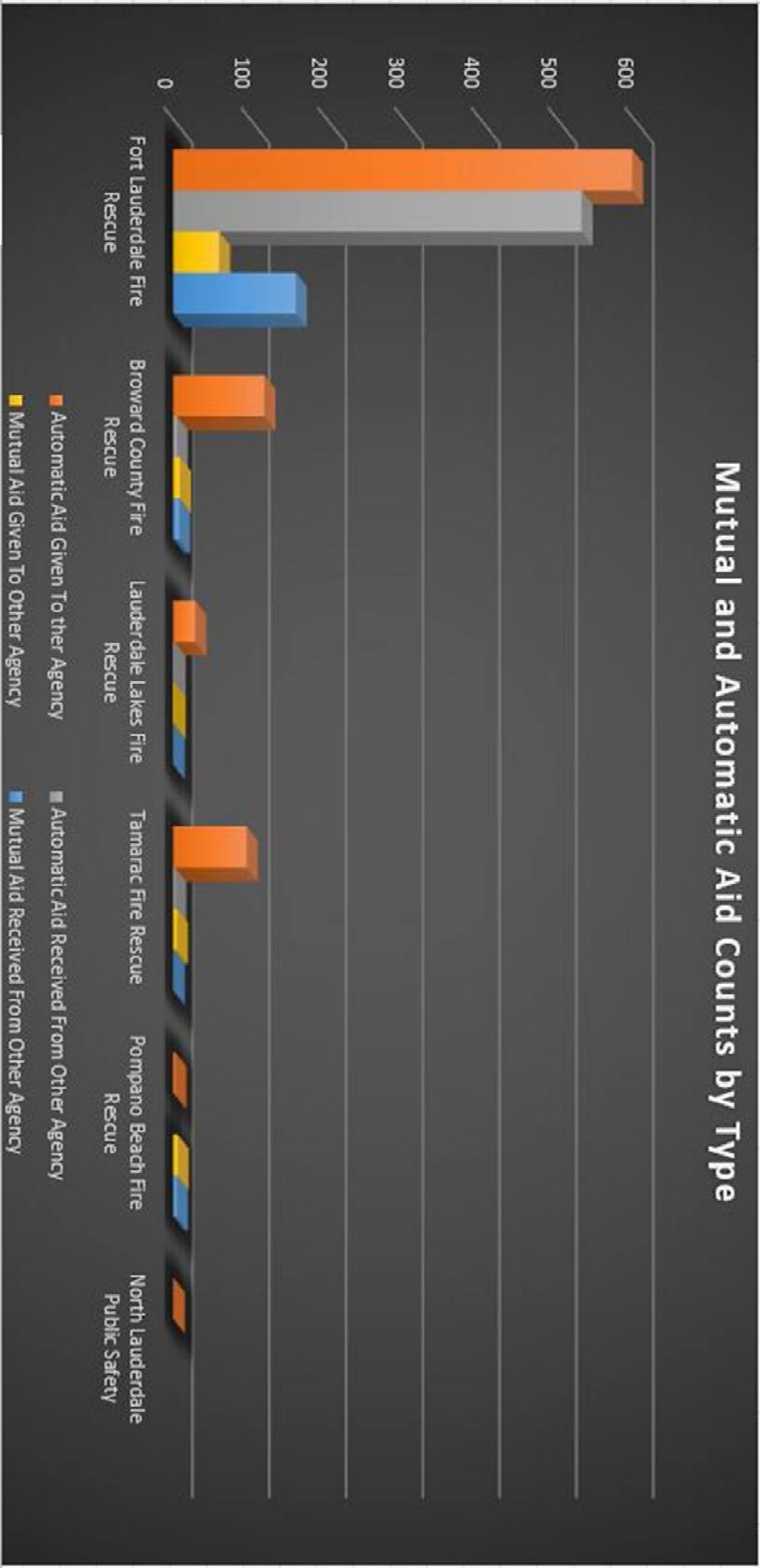

Oakland Park Fire Rescue Annual 2022 Top 10 Incident Locations



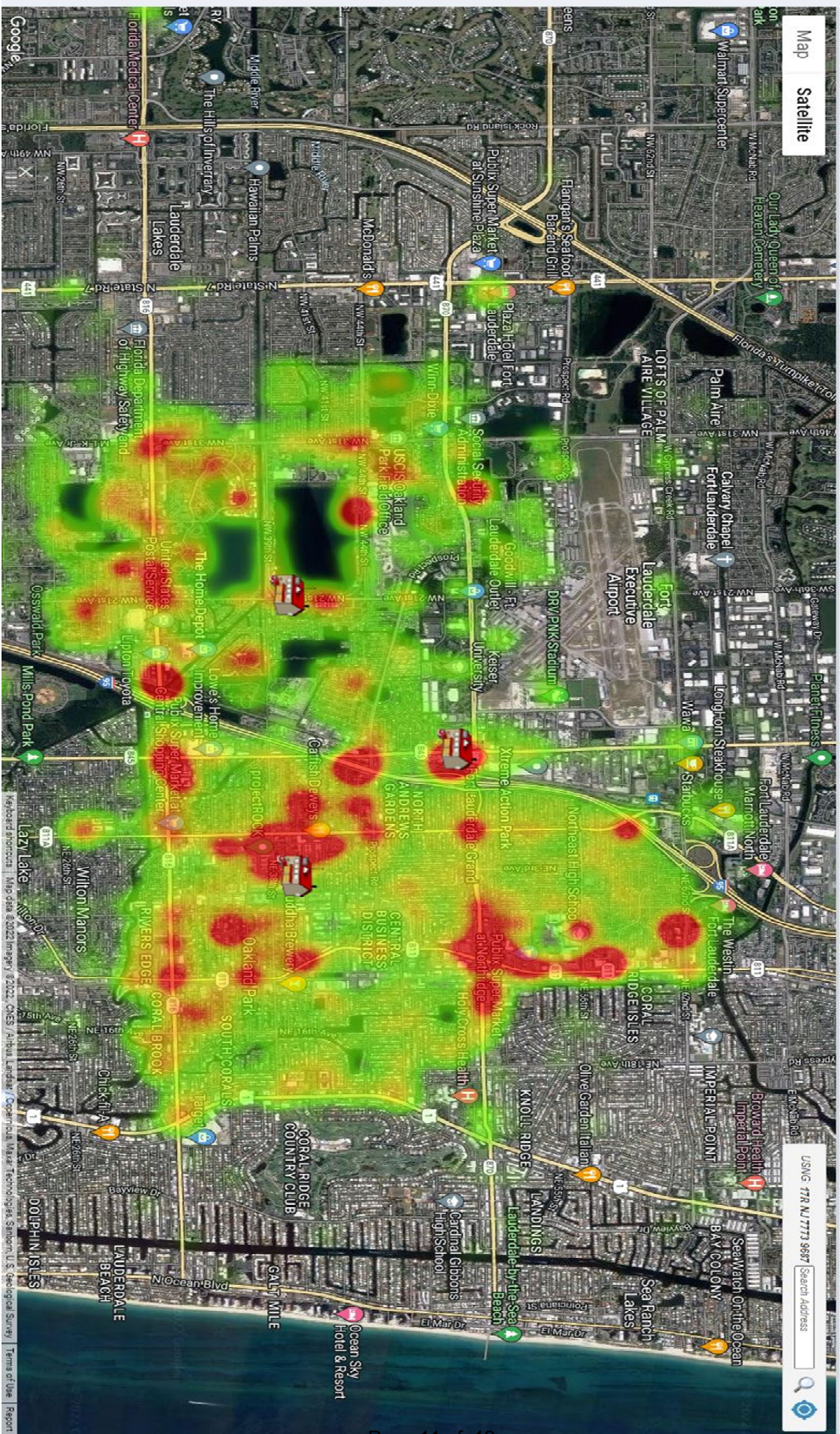

Volume Heat Map Incidents From 10/2021 To 09/2022

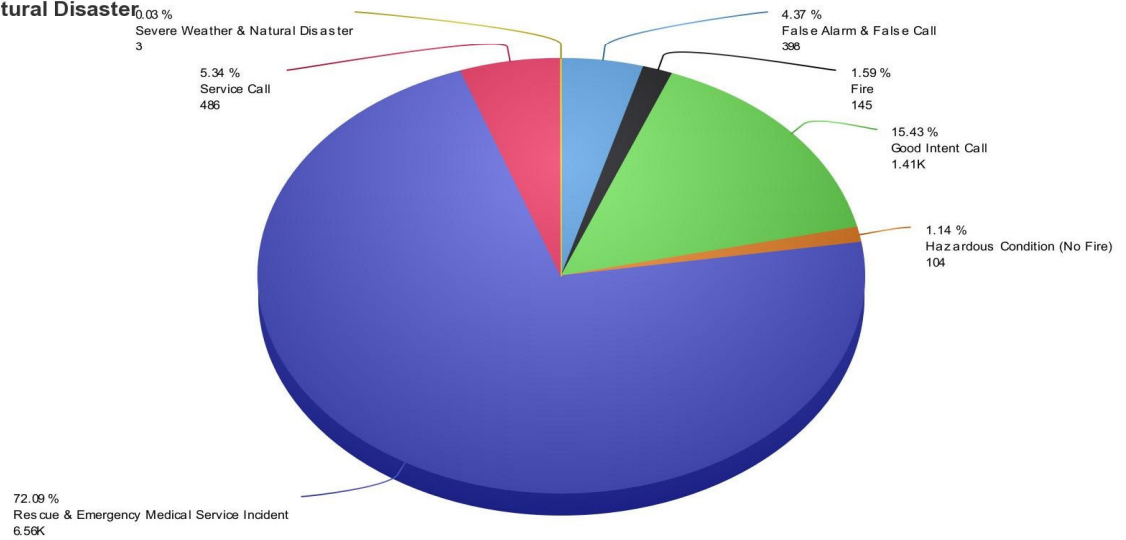
