9	THE STATE AGENCIES REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 163,
10	PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR
11	SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND
12	PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14	WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park, Florida proposes a text amendment to
15	the City's Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 163 of
16	the Florida Statutes by creating Section 11, entitled "Property Rights;" and

18	WHEREAS, the Community and Economic Development Department of the City
19	recommends that the City Commission amend the City's Comprehensive Plan by creating
20	Section 11, entitled "Private Rights;" and
21	
22	WHEREAS, public hearings were held by the City of Oakland Park Local
23	Planning Agency and Planning & Zoning Board to allow for public participation in
24	relation to the preparation and review of the proposed amendment to the City's
25	Comprehensive Plan by creating Section 11, entitled "Private Rights;" and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the first public hearing was held on, 2023 by the City
28	Commission of the City of Oakland Park to allow for public participation in relation to
29	the preparation and review of the proposed amendment to the City's Comprehensive Plan
30	by creating Section 11, entitled "Private Rights;" and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida has
33	determined that the public has been given the opportunity to_adequately participate in the
34	planning process as required by Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes during the
35	preparation and desires that the amendment be transmitted to the Florida Department of
36	Economic Opportunity "DEO;" and

1 2	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:

4 5	SECTION 1 . The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

7	SECTION 2 . The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida hereby
8	approves and adopts the proposed amendment to the City's Comprehensive Plan by
9	creating Section 11, entitled "Private Rights;" is as follows:

11	PROPERTY RIGHTS

13	Goal 11 To ensure that private property rights are protected and considered in the
14	City's decision-making processes.
15	
16	Objective 11.1 The City shall protect and preserve private property rights.
17	Delice 11 1 1 Decreate Dichter The evenes of well assessed to bell hove assessed assessed
18 19	Policy 11.1.1 Property Rights: The owner of real property shall have private property
20	rights protected and preserved as follows in accordance with Florida Statutes:
21	a) The right of a property owner to physically possess and
22	control his or her interests in the property, including easements,
23	leases, or mineral rights.
24	b) The right of a property owner to use, maintain, develop,
25	and improve his or her property for personal use or the use of
26	any other person, subject to state and local ordinances.
27	c) The right of the property owner to privacy and to exclude
28	others from the property to protect the owner's possessions and
29	property.
30	d) The right of a property owner to dispose of his or her
31	property through sale or gift.
32	
33	SECTION 3 . The City Clerk is further directed to transmit a certified copy of this
34	Ordinance to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity "DEO" pursuant to
35	Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, as well as any other interested governmental entity.
36	
37	SECTION 4. If any clause, section, or other part of this Ordinance shall be held
38	by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such
39	unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affecting
40	the validity of the other provisions of this Ordinance.
