All exhibits attached hereto are hereby 25 incorporated herein. 26 27 **SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby 28 approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute the Funding Agreement 29 Between The City Of Oakland Park And The Broward County Sheriff's Office (BSO) 30 for the 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program and 31 authorizes the reimbursement to BSO for the funds utilized in overtime under the 2019 32 JAG grant.
