# BSO Oakland Park Quarterly Report

## January 2026 – March 2026

- This 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Report represents achievements of the Broward Sheriff's Office, Oakland Park District from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, through March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.
- Each shift's primary goal is to ensure Oakland Park remains a safe place to live, work, visit, and play while strengthening the community bond between the Oakland Park District and those we serve.
- BSO's Oakland Park District remains committed to active participation in city functions and events, demonstrating our ongoing dedication to community policing. This quarter, district personnel were fully immersed in seasonal festivities, including Oktoberfest, the Holiday Village, as well as giving back with Thanksgiving meal deliveries, and toy donations to families in need.
- A look at our stats this quarter show that overall, Oakland Park District's enforcement efforts (holiday operations plans, burglary determent plans, etc.) are successful, as crime continues to drop each quarter, compared with previous years.
- First Quarter 2026 Calls for Service (11,313):
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026 Calls for Service are 4.1% **higher** than 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2025 Calls for Service (10,872).
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2025 Calls for Service were -6.5% **less** than 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2024 Calls for Service (11,624).
  - The average 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Calls for Service, comparing years 2022 to 2026, is **11,313**.
  - The Oakland Park District is currently at the 5-year 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter average for Calls for Service.





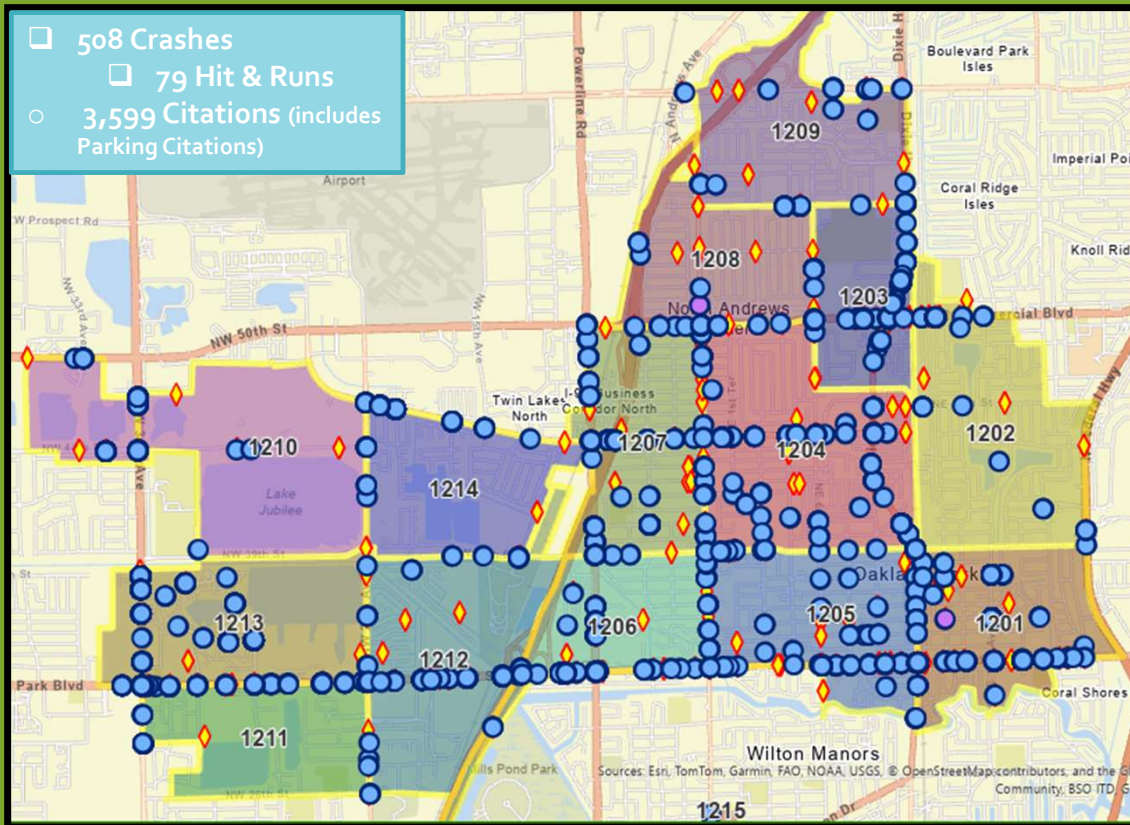

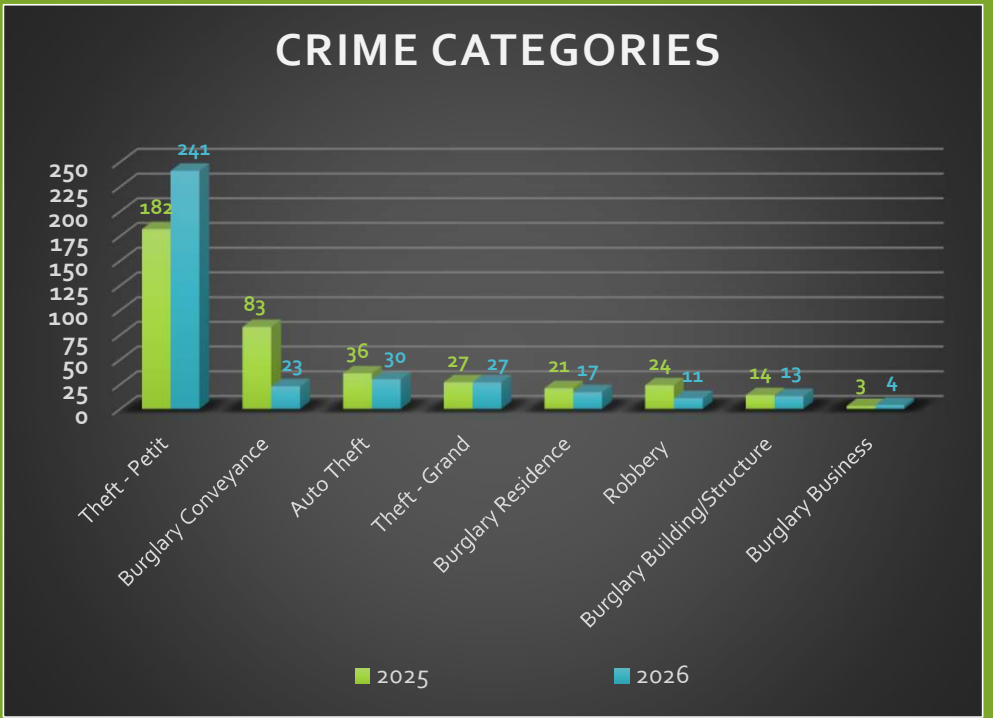
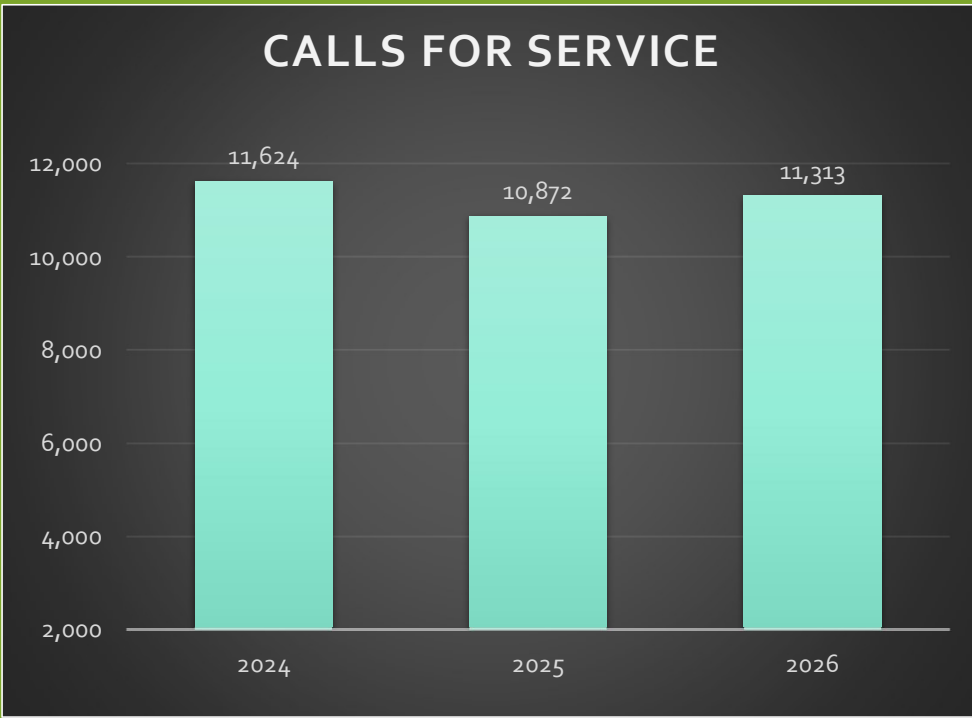
