**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH WATERFORD FLORIDA STAFFING, LLC D/B/A STAFFING CONNECTION FOR CROSSING GUARD SERVICES FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWO YEAR TERM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the proper city officials to execute a Second Amendment to Agreement with Waterford Florida Staffing, LLC D/B/A Staffing Connection for crossing guard services for an additional two year term for the period August 1, 2024, through July 31, 2026.

**SECTION 3.** The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

**SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

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**SECTION 6.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.



**SECOND RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT FOR  
CROSSING GUARD SERVICES**

**WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park**, a Florida municipal corporation (the "City") and doing business, located in Broward County, Florida entered into an Agreement for **Crossing Guard Services** on September 3, 2020, resolution R-2020-105.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants, the City and **Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC D/B/A Action Labor and Staffing Connection** (the "Contractor"), do agree to enter into this second 2-year renewal term providing that:

1. The Contractor will continue to provide citywide crossing guard services in accordance with the scope of work identified in Invitation to Bid (ITB) # 063020, and in Contractor's bid submittal.
2. Due to State of Florida mandated yearly minimum wage increases, the Contractor's hourly rate will increase to \$17.94 beginning September 30, 2024, and \$19.32 beginning September 30, 2025.
3. The term of the original Agreement was two (2) consecutive years with an option to renew for three (3) additional 2-year periods, unless notice of termination was provided by either party at least 60 days prior to the end of the initial contract period.
4. The first 2-year renewal period will expire July 31, 2024, and the second renewal will cover the 2-year period August 1, 2024, through July 31, 2026, after which one (1) 2-year renewal option will remain.
5. All terms, conditions, and provisions of the Invitation to Bid #063020 are incorporated herein by reference and made specific part hereof.
