Assumptions, Clarifications, and Exclusions

1. Costs associated with off-duty police officers, traffic control officers, or any agency-required personnel are excluded and shall be provided by others unless otherwise noted.
2. All permit fees, utility connection fees, impact fees, and associated costs are excluded from this proposal.
3. Existing excavated material is assumed to be suitable for reuse as backfill. Import of select fill or disposal of unsuitable material is excluded unless otherwise noted.
4. Temporary staging and storage of materials, equipment, and spoils are assumed to be permitted on-site or within reasonable proximity to the work area at no additional cost. It is further assumed that the City will designate and provide areas within the public right-of-way (ROW) for temporary storage of excavated spoils. Costs associated with the restoration of these designated staging areas will be compensated under the applicable contract pay items.
5. Density testing within swale or landscaped areas is not included.
6. This proposal is based solely on the items, quantities, and scope explicitly identified herein. Any additional work not specifically listed is excluded.
7. Restoration is limited to trench areas only. Milling & repaving, full roadway, driveway, sidewalk, or landscaping restoration beyond disturbed limits is excluded unless specifically noted.
8. It is assumed that the existing water main has a minimum of 4 feet of cover and that the corporation stops for the existing water services are functional and can be operated to shut off and abandon the existing water services.
9. Work is assumed to occur during standard working hours. Overtime, night work, or work outside permitted hours, if required, will be at additional cost.
