A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A FIRST RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT FOR EVENT MANAGEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK AND SOUTH FLORIDA FOOD AND WINE, INC; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to execute a First Renewal and Amendment of Agreement for Event Management Services between the City of Oakland Park and South Florida Food and Wine, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the proper city officials to execute a First Renewal and Amendment of Agreement for Event Management Services between the City of Oakland Park and South Florida Food and Wine, Inc., and hereby authorizes expenditure up to the budgeted availability. A copy of the First Renewal is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 3. The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

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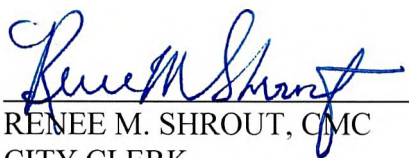

**FIRST RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT
OF AGREEMENT
FOR EVENT MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park, a Florida municipal corporation (the "City"), and **South Florida Food and Wine, Inc.** (the "Contractor") entered into an Agreement for Event Management Services on June 17, 2021, Resolution R-2021-071.

WHEREAS, the contract term was for three (3) years with an option to renew for two (2) additional 2-year periods.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, the City and the Contractor agree to enter into this 2-year renewal term providing that:

- 1 The Contractor will continue to provide Event Management Services.
- 2 The term of this 2-year renewal Agreement shall be for the period October 1, 2024, through September 31, 2026, after which one (1) 2-year renewal will remain.
- 3 All terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement are incorporated herein by reference and made a specific part hereof.
- 4 The renewal and Amendment will provide for annual event fee structure in Exhibit A from \$85,000 to \$100,000, plus an annual increase of 3% for year 2 of the renewal.
- 5 Services rendered unrelated to the Events in Exhibit A; the hourly rate will increase from \$40/hour to \$47/hour for additional consulting services.

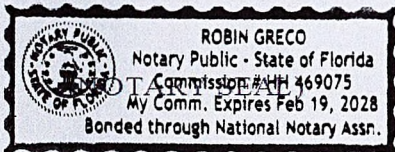
