A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A 1-YEAR SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH KEYLITE POWER & LIGHTING CORP. FOR ONGOING MAINTENANCE AND AS-NEEDED REPAIRS TO THE USDD PHOENIX G2 FIRE STATION ALERTING SYSTEMS LOCATED AT ALL THREE (3) OAKLAND PARK FIRE STATIONS, FOR THE TIME PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2025, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, PIGGYBACKING BROWARD COUNTY CONTRACT R1426611P1_2 PRICING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to approve and authorize a 1-year service agreement with Keylite Power & Lighting Corp. for ongoing maintenance and as-needed repairs to the USDD Phoenix G2 fire station alerting systems located at all three (3) Oakland Park fire stations, for the time period October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, piggybacking Broward County Contract R1426611P1_2 pricing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true and correct and hereby ratified and confirmed by the City Commission. All exhibits attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. In accepting the recommendation of City staff, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes a 1-year service agreement with Keylite Power & Lighting Corp. for ongoing maintenance and as-needed repairs to the USDD Phoenix G2 fire station alerting systems located at all three (3) Oakland Park fire stations, for the time period October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026, piggybacking Broward County Contract R1426611P1_2 pricing.

SECTION 3. The appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
