A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE OF _____ FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL OPERATING FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2027; ADOPTING THE REQUIRED MILLAGE LEVY FOR VOTED DEBT SERVICE FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS SERIES 2020 FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2027; ADOPTING THE REQUIRED MILLAGE LEVY FOR VOTED DEBT SERVICE FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS SERIES 2022 FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2027; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared estimating expenses and revenues of the City of Oakland Park, Florida, for the ensuing year, with detailed information, including revenues to be derived from sources other than ad valorem levy, and the City Manager has made recommendations as to the amount to be appropriated for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has met and considered the recommendations, the suggested tentative budget, and the tentative millage to be levied to carry on the government of the City for the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The tentative operating millage rate necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida, to produce a sufficient sum which together with departmental and other revenues will be sufficient to pay for appropriations made in the tentative budget for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

Section 2. The tentative millage levy for voted debt service necessary to be levied against ad valorem valuation of property subject to taxation in the City of Oakland Park, Florida to produce a sufficient sum of revenues sufficient to pay for General Obligation Bonds Series 2020 for the fiscal year is hereby set at _____ mills.

44 **Section 3.** The tentative millage levy for voted debt service necessary

58 **Section 5.** The Operating Millage adopted herein is lesser/greater than the
59 rolled-back rate of _____ mills computed pursuant to the TRIM Act (Section
60 200.065, Florida Statutes, 2002, as amended) by ____%. This percentage shall
61 be known as the percentage decrease/increase in property taxes adopted by the
62 City.

64 **Section 6.** The tentative budget advertisement in compliance with Florida
65 Statute 200.065 shall be published in one issue of a newspaper published in
66 Broward County, Florida, and at the same time the public will be notified of a
67 public hearing to be held at 6:30 p.m. on the 23rd day of September 2026, in
68 City Commission Chambers of City Hall, 1100 Park Lane East, Oakland Park,
69 Florida, for the purpose of hearing objections or criticisms of the tentative
70 budget and millage. This meeting is for the purpose of setting a Final Tax Levy
71 and Final Budget.

73 **Section 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held
74 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such
75 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and shall in no
76 way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

78 **Section 6.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are
79 hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

81 **Section 7.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and
82 adoption.
